THE EXTRAORDINARY JOURNEY

Armos's past life's experiences can only be described as miraculous and beyond imagination. Despite his parent's objection and what seemed to be an impossible dream for a minor at the age of 15, he dared to venture out to an unknown world all alone. He was determined in making his dreams come true. Finally, after a year's wait for the Exit Visa, with only \$50 in his possession, he headed to the Tripoli airport for the flight to Valletta, Malta and on to Rome. Sadly, he had no choice but to abandon his family and school friends for a new life by attempting and successfully escaping the constant political and religious persecution which he endured in Libya because he was of a different faith.

In Rome he managed to house himself by using cardboard boxes to sleep in the open-air markets, until a charity organization member noticed him and offered him temporary housing in a refugee camp and later transferred to a pensione in the Santa Lucia area of Naples until he was allowed to re-settle in Israel.

At the age of 23, after serving and educating himself in the Israeli military for five years, and against all odds, he had decided to return to Italy and try to make his dreams come true by seeking to discover the one and only country in the world where, with education and hard work, dreams do come true- the USA - where he worked his way through school and gained his education in the legal field.


